This is the current information as of January 11, 2008. It will be changing on a daily basis. The best and easiest place to see what's available is on the [www.biglube.com](http://www.biglube.com) web site. I'll try to keep everything up to date on each product information page.

When an order arrives I pick items from inventory, process payment, package and ship the order. If there are item(s) on the order that are not in stock, payment will not be processed until the buyer is contacted, either by email or telephone. Payment only for items shipped will be processed. Payment may be made by Visa, Mastercard, personal check or money order. I prefer not to use Pay Pal. All Internet orders are secure by two encoded systems. It's redundant, but it's very safe.

Back orders will be filled as soon as the back ordered items are in stock. It is my policy to contact each buyer before shipping back ordered items by either email or telephone.

I get many calls about products, availability, cost, shipping and other issues. I welcome each of these calls. This kind of communication is the most satisfactory way to insure happy shooters.

I was reluctant to discontinue the little .32 caliber Big Lube™ mold as a stock item. The sales for this little bullet were just too slow to continue to stock it. If there is enough interest in the future, I'll do a Subscription Order.

Subscription Orders differ from the so called "Group Buy" orders in that when the sale window opens the sale close date is known. This is to prevent a sale from running on indefinitely and having the first pard that ordered wait the longest. If a Subscription Order exceeds 25 units, there is no "Setup Fee Surcharge". If the sale has less than 25 units, the "Setup Surcharge Fee" of \$100 is divided equally between all of the sale buyers. I don't like to do Subscription orders but if there is enough demand, they are sometimes the only way to get the exact mold that a number of shooters want.
